

# SUSTAINABLE LANDSCAPE CHECKLIST

You're almost to the finish line! Read the terms and conditions one last time and review through the checklist before submitting your final project pictures. Make sure you've met/done the following:



- All sprinklers have been capped, removed or converted to drip irrigation (NO overhead irrigation).
- All turf has been removed in the project area and covered with weed barrier material, preferably organic.
- All weed barrier material and exposed soil is covered with at least three inches of mulch.
- The project has one of the following rain capture techniques—a rain garden, rain barrel, cistern, infiltration trench, vegetated swale, berm, dry river bed, grade, or retention pond.
- The project area must include at least 3 plants per 100 square feet; LADWP recommends native, drought tolerant, and California Friendly® plants.
- A maximum of 25 percent of the project area is allowed to be covered with non-vegetated material such as pavers, gravel, decomposed granite, decorative rocks, sand, etc.
- No artificial turf is installed.
- No invasive plants have been included in the project area.
- If the project includes a parkway, the California Friendly® and native plants will fill in 80 percent of the parkway project area. Be sure you meet all requirements for parkway landscaping.
